- CiteUlike es un programa de redes sociales o marcadores sociales gratuito que ayuda a almacenar, organizar, compartir y recomendar los artículos científicos que estás leyendo o que ha publicado una institución.
- Cuando se encuentra un artículo en la web de interés, se puede añadir a la biblioteca personal presionando un botón. CiteULike extrae de la web automáticamente los detalles de la referencia bibliográfica.
- También se pueden importar los registros bibliográficos de una base de datos referencial como SCOPUS o ISI Web of Science en formato RIS o BibTex sobre un tema en particular o las documentos publicados por una institución.

 Oversity Ltd. se estableció para desarrollar y soportar CiteULike,
 actualmente esta soportada por la empresa Springer Media.
- CiteULike es un sistema abierto a cualquier persona que permite conservar, manejar y compartir en internet referencias de documentos científicos y técnicos, que se conservan como propias pero visibles para todos
- Las referencias se capturan mediante un marcador de favoritos, que se instala fácilmente en el explorador y extrae los datos bibliográficos que aparecen en una página web. Al incorporarlas, se clasifican en áreas temáticas y les asigna un término de indización o etiqueta (tag).
- Las referencias también se pueden capturar e integrar desde fuentes aceptadas, una lista de importantes editores y distribuidores de contenidos, abiertos y comerciales




Self-citation is common practice in most sciences but it differs between disciplines, countries and journals. Here we report on self-citation in soil science. We investigated citations in the major soil science journals and conducted an analysis on a country basis and for the subdiscipline of Pedometrics. It was found that the median rate of individual self-citation was 12%, and ranged from 5 to 60% in 31 soil science journals. A high rate of journal self-citation was accompanied by a high impact factor ranking, but ranking based on the Eigenfactor™ revealed a very different ranking compared to the impact factor score ranking. The distribution of country self-citation rate follows a power law, and a logarithmic function was fitted to the data. Taking into account the logarithmic function, China had high rates of self-citations whereas Egypt, Algeria, Ukraine, and Indonesia have low levels of self-citations. With few exceptions, self-citation rates in soil science are reasonable and comparable to the other biophysical sciences.






- Item-Item Co-Occurrence (IICO) We look to see how often each article is paired with another in all other users' libraries and choose those which occur most often.
- User-Based Collaborative Filter (UBCF) We find other libraries that are most similar to your and select articles from those other libraries.






